It is our pleasure that Integrated Project for Development of People (IPDP) has successfully completed its 12 years, since its inception. The Services were rendered to the Community and children in Bangalore urban District from 2004 to 2016. We are serving in the field of education for poor children and running the projects to mainstream for formal education presently handling programs are NCLP National child Labor Project from Labour Department, Creche (Early Child Care and Education) from Yahoo Employees Foundation, India, Ashakirana residential shelter from MCKS TRUST FUND and Weir Mineral India from all projects we mainstreamed about 1600 children and in the field of Women's empowerment and Development. We have rendered our services to around 9500 women's in terms of counseling support, family dispute referrals and loan facilities for SHG's yearly at an average of 13 to 15 crores of loan amount linkages made with ICICI BANK in order to meet their financial needs. They are also assisted to start self-employment activities to develop their own business and supporting their families as supplementary income to manage their families. And we are also working in the field of skill training for youths yearly about 120 students from smile foundation, under MDM mid day meal scheme food supplying for Govt., and Aided schools about 8500 children and feeding program for 300 senior citizens and health camp beneficiaries for 1200 people from MCKS TRUST FUND

With the immense support, guidance and cooperation of our esteemed Board of Trustees, it was all successful to execute our plans and targets in reality. My heartfelt thanks to my Board of Trustees, our Staff Team Members Funding /donor Agencies, Government scheme executors, supporting Institutions, and the concern department personnel's and community and children.

We acknowledge all other NGO's and various Networks in Bangalore helping us to reach out the children in order to deliver the services like education, skill training, feeding, health care, rehabilitation, safety and protection of children. They also helped us to make advocacy and policy interventions on child rights issues.

Background of IPDP:-

Integrated Project for Development of People (IPDP) marked its beginning in the year 2004 by a handful number of social workers and likeminded people, who always wish to serve the poor, marginalized, disadvantaged and other vulnerable people in the society. The main focus was on education, health, basic amenities for the needy in the community, vocational training in order to create awareness on women empowerment as well as child rights. The exact plan was successfully executed through trainings, workshops and direct exposure visits through a sustainable approach including participative intervention in the community. Services and Awareness is always our top priority in all of our programs. Our role as a Facilitator between the Community and the Government has successfully yielded fruitful results. We organize various kinds of awareness programs for the slum communities. We have always made sure to get ready the community to fight for their demands from the concern departments.

Aims of the Organization:

Welfare and Development of all Children up to 18 years, Empowerment and Development of Women in the Society and Community Development without discrimination irrespective of caste, colour and creed in the Society.

CORE OBJECTIVES OF THE TRUST:

- Welfare and Development and empowerment of the urban poor.
- To promote awareness of various social issues, including health, education, gender discrimination, human rights and legal entitlement.
- To provide Vocational skills training for young people to become self employed or to join the skilled workforce of India.

- To Run NCLP (National child Labour Project) a Child Labourers Rehabilitation Special School for 100 children in two places in Bangalore districts.
- To Run Pre-primary Education (Creche) centers for 3 to 6years Children for 150 children in Bangalore urban district.
- To Run Residential hostel for 100 poor Children as their family backgrounds are pathetic such as broken families, alcoholic families and single parents' children in Nandhini layout, Bangalore.
- To Run Akshara Dasoha (Mid Day Meal programme) for about 8000 children in Government and Aided schools in Bangalore urban district.
- To form and promote by maintaining of 900 SHG (Self help group) under Savings and Credit programme to improve their financial conditions in Bangalore urban district and Tiptur taluk of Tumkur district.
- To run free Skill Tailoring Programme (Job oriented course) for poor adolescent, youths and SHG women's at Bangalore urban slums.

- To execute Computer Literacy Programs in the villages in order to expand the flying wings of technology.
- To work through Larger network for right based issues and continue the work with Bridge network for building the Community groups to fight for rights and get the facilities from the government as a Poverty Alleviation Programme.
- To serve in Feeding project by cooking and supplying one time food to the senior Citizens for 1200 peoples at Dr.Ramana Rao's Village clinic, T.Begur, Nelamangala Taluk, Bangalore Rural District.
- To serve feeding for senior citizens in the slums about 300 persons those who suffer for to get one meal in a day.
- To create legal awareness to the needy women by organizing the women Legal rights workshops in collaboration with other NGO's.
- To run women counselling centres (help centres) for those who are in need like family dispute, domestic violence, harassments at work places or at home can also get counselling services.
- To work with Government departments to implement the schemes for the benefits of the urban poor in slum areas.
- To participate in Survey work and census work with Government departments like population survey, Child labour Survey, out of school children survey, disable survey and slum survey projects.
- To organise Trainings for staff for the refresh ness and to reach out their plans and targets in the projected year.
- To organize old clothes and materials for NCLP Children, Ashakirana children, NRBC and crèche children for their use.
- To organize monthly Health check ups to Crèche and NCLP Children.
- To Conduct Sports to Crèche and Ashakirana hostel Children.
- To Conduct Cultural programmes to Crèche and Ashakirana hostel Children.
- To conduct monthly Parents meetings regularly for Crèche and NCLP Children.
- To participate in other NGO's intercultural activities and programmes.

Achievements of the year 2016:

- From NCLP Child Labourers Rehabilitation Special school, we enrolled 50 children in our NCLP special school and mainstreamed 36 child Labourers into formal school. And doing Follow ups for their retention and prevention of dropout from the formal School.
- Enrolled 32 children from our Creche centers to primary schools through the (RTE) Right To Education Act to Various schools in Nandhini layout location and in Parikrma Humanity

Foundation school.

- Serving food for about 8500 children for 81 Govt. and Govt. Aided schools under Mid day Meal programme in Bangalore Urban District and Village Panchayat limit Areas around Greater Bangalore Limits.
- (SHG Programme) Savings and Thrift programme , we have formed and promoted 648 SHG's and Organized finance arrangement/linkage with ICICI BANK about more than 13 to 15 crores in the year 2016.
- Books writing trainings given to 780 SHG Representatives of various SHG's (Self Help Group) formed by IPDP.
- Organized Staff Training programme on various issues for the Staff team focusing On Women Empowerment, Child Rights and community Development.
- Organized Legal workshops for slum people at Ullala Upanagara, Laggere and Jaibhuvaneshwari nagar, Nandhini layout, Bangalore-96
- Workshops Conducted for the staff members on "SHG Concepts and Books writing and Records keeping in the SHG's.
- Organized Local Educational trip to Ashakirana hostel Children.

- Trained under computer training for 120 students

SHG (Self help group) saving and credit programme: -

IPDP has been running the Savings and credit program for the needy women's in the slums and semi developed Areas, under this project formed and promoted more than 855 SHG's (self-help groups) in various areas of Bangalore Urban District and Tiptur taluk Tumkur District. Presently we are working with 25 slum areas and 5 hoblis of Tiptur Taluk, for the SHG's is concern we are always guiding them to manage and maintain the groups in good condition without default. Our staffs provide them the proper trainings on Group concepts and Maintenance of their Groups. In case the Group requires exposure and inputs, we organize the exposure visits to SHG Sangha. Each Staff members have been assigned with the specific numbers of groups like minimum 60 to maximum 80 groups. The main role of the coordinators is to visit the groups frequently and attend the monthly meetings. If any group requires loan, then the coordinators should inform the same to the office with the ready for linkage group details and do the follow ups for the loan process. Once the loan is disbursed, the coordinators have to follow the repayment work with the groups by collecting their EMI's / installments and depositing in their Group accounts. Our coordinators mainly play a role of Facilitator between the groups and ICICI BANK. We are recommending minimum Rs.1.5 lakh to maximum Rs.8 lakh per group to the ICICI Bank. This year we organized loan from ICICI Bank more than Rs. 12 to m15 Crores to the SHG's.

NCLP SPECIAL SCHOOL:-

IPDP's the very first Objective is eradication of Child Labour system in the society to reach our objective we started the National Child Labor Project (NCLP) since its inception i.e. 2004 and till date we are running this project. The main objective of this project is to provide the rights of education; every child should enjoy their childhood rights up to the age of 14 years but in our country there are many children are working bellow the age of 14 years hence to eradicate the child Labour system in our country The Ministry of labour, Government of India has introduced this scheme, IPDP is working with the Government as join hands and running successfully the NCLP project by rehabilitating the child laborers and mainstreaming

them to the formal school. Since 2004, IPDP has enrolled 657 children and mainstreamed to around 509 children. Out of the 509 children, 380 children are still continuing their education in the formal schools. From IPDP NCLP special school promoted children are studying from standard 5th standard to up to B.COM. We are planning to increase the number of children in the NCLP project by starting one more NCLP center. We do follow up to ensure for their continuity in education. It is a very good program to enroll the child laborers in order to join the formal schooling and stay out of labor sector. NCLP is supported by Ministry of Labor, Government of India and is implemented through the State Society for the Eradication of Child Labor. It is under the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner of Bangalore Urban district, Bangalore.

Ashakirana residential hostel:-

Ashakirana residential shelter was started at Jaibhuvaneshwari nagar in 2006 especially for the poor children with the support of Sarva Shikshana Abhiyana SSA government of India. The main aim of the scheme is to main stream the children who are out of school in Bangalore urban District and the Ashakirana residential shelter for “Children in Crisis” started at Jaibhuvaneshwari nagar, Nandhini layout, Bangalore - 96 for 60 to 65 children and presently 56 children are benefiting from this project and enrolled in the Government school from 2nd Standard to 12th Standard and continuing their studies. They are provided with all sorts of facilities such as food, clothing, recreation, education and other required facilities. The main background of the children are from alcoholic families, broken families, single parents and other children facing various sorts of problems and which children are really needed support for continue their studies incase if we do not give admission then they stop their education and they go for work or simply waste their time and their future, therefore we approached our Donors and continuing the Ashakirana shelter for poor children since last 10 years. The shelter provides individual stay rooms for

boys and girls by the school authorities. And the Residential Shelter is supported by MCKS TRUST FUND for feeding of children and WEIR MINERAL INDIA for Maintenance of Salary and other requirements

Akshara Dasoha (Mid Day Meal programme):

IPDP is successfully running Akshara Dasoha Mid Day Meal program for around 8500 children in Government, Government aided schools and NCLP special schools in Bangalore urban district. The main objective of the scheme is to reduce the number of dropouts and to increase the number of enrollment in Government schools. This scheme is introduced by Government of India and State government with the sharing of 75:25 and the monitoring, supervising and execution of this scheme under Zilla Panchayat, Akshara dasoha section is headed by the EO (Educational Officer), We are serving food about 8500 children in and around 81 Government, Government aided schools and NCLP special schools in Nandhini Layout, Sondekoppa and Ullala clusters. We feel that it is a great challengeable job to us because every day cooking and supplying food for 8500 children is very tough task but to serve for the poor children's benefit we have taken this scheme mid day meal program and implementing this scheme. There are various statistics about out of school children nearly 5 lakh children are out of school and have entered to various sectors and establishments to work. But to bring back to school Government has introduced various schemes in order to enroll children to the schools. The Mid Day Meal program is playing a very great major role in increasing the number of enrollment and retention of school dropouts.

CRECHE PROGRAMME:

IPDP has initiated Early Childhood Care and Education program for the children ranging from 3-6 years as pre primary education especially for the poor children in the slum areas. The main objective of the program is to prevent malnutrition and to improve the health condition. The program also aims to provide basic education for the poor children. IPDP marked its beginning for the Creche program in Jaibhuvaneshwari Nagar in Nandini Layout. Around 669 children are totally enrolled in the crèche from the period 2004-2016. The children are then promoted to various other schools. Around 530 children are studying in Standard 1 to Standard 7 in Raghurama primary school, Highway public school, Bangalore central public school, Nandhini public school, Parikrma humanity foundation and other recognized schools in the nearby areas. IPDP has set its target to enroll the poor children in Creche so that they are not deprived from their birth rights. We are running this program to help the working women and to educate the people in slums to send their children for formal education. It helps in eradicating malnutrition and it also creates a good awareness for education and health aspects. The health checkup camps are also initiated for providing effective medical treatment to the crèche center. Around 125 children are getting benefit under this program on an annual basis. This project is supported by Yahoo Employee Foundation India, Bangalore.

Poverty Alleviation Programme:

Bridge network is basically a collective of 11 NGO's platform together who are involved in implementing right based programs. Each NGO has selected 2-3 slums of their area where there is real need and requirement. In the year 2006, IPDP selected slums such as Ullala Upanagar and Jai Bhuvaneshwari Nagar in order to work for the best objective. The main objective of the program is to properly mobilize the community and provide them trainings for their rights as well as to get their work done from the concerned departments. In this connection, we are organizing a number of programs especially for the community, women's group and children group in order to fight for their basic amenities such as land, health, education, water, drainage, sanitary system, hospitals, electricity, PDS systems, schools and other types of

issues related to women and children in the slums. Till now we have succeeded to get Primary health center in Ullala Upanagara and high school in Ullala Upanagara. The present focus is mainly on 22.75% scheme with BBMP and we have got sanction for 16 houses, which is in process. We are working with the community for BPL cards and helping them to submit their forms through online means. We are also working for the education rights for the high school construction. The entire program is supported by Action Aid India, Bangalore through the Bridge network.

Feeding Programs for Senior citizens at Bangalore Urban Slums:

IPDP has initiated this program for senior citizens of Bangalore urban slums previously from BBMP support Akshaya Pathra Foundation was serving food to the senior citizens in BBMP limit Areas but in 2013 they stopped the program after that they were waiting this feeding program but from Government it was not restarted, one of our Trustee Mr.S.Jayaraman had long term plan to serve the senior citizens by providing one meal to eradicate hunger of the old age people in the slums from IPDP we approached PRANIC HEALING FOUNDATION/ MCKS TRUST FUND about this feeding for poor Senior Citizens in the Urban slums and really there is a need for one time meal for the poor deserved old people and Identified the beneficiaries and submitted the proposal then this program was started and supporting this project and since last two years and they are supporting us to feed about 300 senior citizens at Jaibhuvaneshwari nagar, Lakshmidewi nagar Lakshmi devi nagara colony and Sanjay nagar slums in Laggere Areas in Bangalore Urban District.

Feeding programme for Senior Citizens:

IPDP started this feeding project in 2006 to provide one meal to the health checkup camp senior citizens at Dr. Ramana Rao's free health checkup camp for the poor patients for the rural area senior citizens the patients leave their home by 6.00 am and they reach the village clinic by 8.00 am and return home by 10.30am, therefore we planned for this poor patients by giving them one meal will give more strength and energy to return home by hope I had something for my stomach and reach their home hence we approached PRANIC HEALING FOUNDATION/ MCKS TRUST FUND to support one meal for 600 patient's and now it is increased up to 1200 patients this free health checkup and treatments started in 1974 by Dr.Ramana Rao and till date he serving for poor last 41 years at his free village clinic T.Begur Nelamangala taluk, Bangalore Rural District. Free service with love and dedication we cannot believe that one person doing health checkup for 1200 person in 4hours interested please give a visit to Dr.Ramana Rao's Village Clinic T.Begur Nelamangala taluk, Bangalore rural District.

SKILL TRAINING PROGRAM :

Integrated Project for Development of People (IPDP) is successfully executing skill development program since 2014. We did a humble beginning and now collaborated with Smile Foundation; we are successfully running the skill development program. We are providing free training and placement to the underprivileged youths nearby Kengeri region. Interested and underprivileged youth with age 18-25 are provided with free computer basics, English, personality and retail management training courses to help them find a good job. Career counseling and exposure visit sessions are done on time to enhance the working capability in the job market. We are soon in the process to tie with other big entities in order to take skill development initiatives to the next level.
