It is our pleasure that Integrated Project for Development of People (IPDP) has successfully completed its 16 years, since its inception. The Services were rendered to the Community and children in Bangalore urban District from 2004 to 2020. I have Received Doctorate Award for Social service for 28 service in Empowering Marginalized & Vulnerable people in the society from Indian Virtual Academy for Peace and Education, We are serving in the field of education for poor children and running the projects to mainstream for formal education presently handling programs are NCLP National child Labor Project from Labour Department, Pre Primary Education (Early Child Care and Education) from Individual donors & well-wishers, Ashakirana residential shelter from MCKS TRUST FUND and Weir Mineral India, from all projects we have mainstreamed about 1900 children and in the field of Women's empowerment and Development. We have rendered our services to around 12100 women's in terms of counseling support, family dispute referrals and loan facilities for SHG's yearly at an average of 13 to 15 cores of loan amount linkages made with ICICI BANK in order to meet their financial needs. They are also assisted to start self-employment activities to develop their own business and supporting their families as supplementary income to manage their families. And we are also working in the field of skill training for youths yearly about 460 students from smile foundation, under MDM mid-day meal scheme food supplying for Govt., and Aided schools about 11500 children and feeding program for 300 senior citizens and health camp beneficiaries for 1200 people from MCKS TRUSTFUND.

With the immense support, guidance and cooperation of our esteemed Board of Trustees, it was all successful to execute our plans and targets in reality. My heartfelt thanks to my Board of Trustees, our Staff Team Members Funding donors, Agencies, Government scheme executors, supporting Institutions, and the concern department personnel's and community and children.

We acknowledge all other NGO's and various Networks in Bangalore helping us to reach out the children in order to deliver the services like education, skill training, feeding, health care, rehabilitation, safety and protection of children. The exact plan was successfully executed through trainings, workshops and direct exposure visits through a sustainable approach including participative intervention in the community. Services and Awareness is always our top priority in all of our programs. Our role as a

Facilitator between the Community and the Government has successfully yielded fruitful results. We organize various kinds of awareness programs for the slum communities. We have always made sure to get ready the community to fight for their demands from the concern departments.

- Since government of India as not renewed the MoU to continue national child labour project this year we have not started the NCLP special project as per action plan
- Enrolled 90 children from our Crèche centers to primary schools through the (RTE) Right To Education Act to Various schools in Nandhini layout location and in Parikrma Humanity Foundation school.
- Running Ashakirana residential shelter for school going children for 54 children at Laggere, Kaverinagar, near Vidhana soudha Layout, Bangalore-58.
- Serving food for about 11000 children for 92 Govt. and Govt. Aided schools under Midday Meal program in Bangalore Urban District and Village Panchayat limit Areas around Greater Bangalore Limits.
- (SHG Program) Savings and Thrift program, we have formed and promoted 1100 SHG's and Organized finance arrangement/linkage with ICICI BANK about more than 13 to 16 crores in the year2019.
- Book writing trainings given to 960 SHG Representatives of various SHG's (Self Help Group) formed by IPDP.
- Provided skill Training for 120 poor adolescent, youths and SHG women's at Bangalore urban slums.
- Provided Computer, spoken English, Personality development, retail Management and financial literacy Programs in the slums and villages in order to expand the flying wings of technology for 460 students and we have placed 368 students so we have achieved 80% job placement.
- Serving in Feeding program to the senior citizen's for 1200 members at Dr.Ramana Rao's Village Clinic .T.Begur, Bangalore rural districts.
- Serving feeding program for senior citizens in Bangalore Urban slums for about 300 persons at four slum Areas.
- Organized Women's rights workshops for 325 women's at IPDP office premises to know about their rights and help the women for those are under violation of their rights and facing problems, resource person Ms. Margret from SICHREM NGO.

- Worked with BBMP department through impact India Consortium and involved in the Survey work of identifying the urban homeless people to provide food and shelter to them to enjoy survival right and to encourage for the dignified life in our society.
- Organized Staff Training program on various issues for the Staff team focusing On Women Empowerment, Child Rights and community Development.
- Organized monthly General Health checkups to Pre primary education children's.
- Conducted Cultural program for Pre Primary education and Ashakirana hostel Children at School Premises.
- Conducted monthly Parents meetings regularly for Pre Primary children's and Ashakirana hostel Children.
- Workshops Conducted for the staff members on "SHG Concepts and Books writing and Records keeping in the SHG's.
- Organized Local Educational trip to Ashakirana hostel Children.
- Formed and managing Community teams at Ullala and Jaibhuvaneshwarinagara for rights based work through Bridge network program.
- Celebrated Independence Day, Republic Day, Children's Day, Teachers Day and Gandhi jayanthi Program at our Creche, NCLP special School, Ashakirana Hostel and Urban Deprived Children residential Shelter (UDC) s to mark the significance of the program to the children, parents and publics.
- Organized legal workshops for SHG women have to resolve the disputes of women issues in the field Area to help the women resolve their issues by counseling.
- To organize SHG Mela for marketing support as sales cum exhibition of SHG products of all SHG affiliated to IPDP due to covid 19 pandemic we did not organize the SHG Mela as per our action .we shall do the same in next year.
- We have distributed more than 22000 dry ration kits to the COVID 19 Pandemic affected people during lockdown like daily wages workers, migrants, transgender community, waste pickers, graveyard workers, HIV infected families, sex workers and other nomadic community

## **SHG (Self help group) saving and credit program: -**

IPDP has been running the Savings and credit program for the needy women's in the slums and semi developed Areas, under this project formed and promoted more than 1050 SHG's (self-help groups) in various areas of Bangalore Urban District and Tiptur taluk Tumkur District. Presently we are working with 30 slum areas and 5 hoblis of Tiptur Taluk, for the SHG's is concern we are always guiding them to manage and maintain the groups in good condition without default. Our staffs provide them the proper trainings on Group concepts and Maintenance of their Groups. In case the Group requires exposure and inputs, we organize the exposure visits to SHG Sangha. Each Staff members have been assigned with the specific numbers of groups like minimum 60 to maximum 80 groups. The main role of the coordinators is to visit the groups frequently and attend the monthly meetings. If any group requires loan, then the coordinators should inform the same to the office with the ready for linkage group details and do the follow ups for the loan process. Once the loan is disbursed, the coordinators have to follow the repayment work with the groups by collecting their EMI's / installments and depositing in their Group accounts. Our coordinators mainly play a role of Facilitator between the groups and ICICI BANK. We are recommending minimum Rs.1.5 lakh to maximum Rs.10 lakh per group to the ICICI Bank. This year we organized loan from ICICI Bank more than Rs. 13 to m16 Crores to theSHG's.

### **Livelihood Program and promotion of Entrepreneurs in SHGs:**

A project for women has been started by IPDP and continuing as a savings and thrift program to help the women financially to promote self-Employment and develop their small enterprises and to repay their higher interest loans. We found that most of slum dwellers do not have a steady income and to maintain their homes and families they borrow from local financiers at daily interest rates and mortgage their articles and home appliances. They sometimes end up with paying their entire income to the financiers and are subject to their harassment. We found there is a need to educate and help the community especially the woman. To improve socio-economic

status of women from urban slum communities in Bangalore. The main aim of the project is to generate a source of income for women in a background where they are treated differently and can supplement the family income by supporting 300 women directly and 1200 Family members indirectly for the livelihood activities by promoting to establish a entrepreneurship to lead life and encourage the women in the society to support for the their empowerment. This project is aligned with national Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) indicators.

## **Ashakirana residential hostel:-**

Ashakirana residential shelter was started at Jaibhuvaneshwari Nagar in 2006 especially for the poor children with the support of Sarva ShikshanaAbhiyana (SSA) Government of India. The main aim of the scheme is to main stream the children who are out of school in Bangalore urban District and the Ashakirana residential shelter for “Children in Crisis” shifted from Jaibhuvaneshwarinagar, to No.2, 1<sup>st</sup>cross Kaverinagar, Laggere Bangalore 560058 for 58 to 60 children and presently 50 children are benefiting from this project and enrolled in Mother Theresa school from 2nd Standard to 10<sup>th</sup> Standard and continuing their studies. They are provided with all sorts of facilities such as food, clothing, recreation, education and other required facilities. The main background of the children are from alcoholic families, broken families, single parents and other children facing various sorts of problems and which children are really needed support for continue their studies incase if we do not give admission then they stop their education and they go for work or simply waste their time and their future, therefore we approached our Donors and continuing the Ashakirana shelter for poor children since last 14years. The shelter provides individual stay rooms for boys and girls And the Residential Shelter is supported by MCKS TRUST FUND for feeding of children and WEIR MINERAL INDIA for Maintenance of Salary and other requirements. We would also like include the all our Ashakirana students who were Pursing 10<sup>th</sup> standard scored 100% results with good Marks.

## **Akshara Dasoha (Mid Day Meal programme):**

IPDP is successfully running Akshara Dasoha Mid Day Meal program for around 10482 children in Government, Government aided schools and NCLP special schools in Bangalore urban district. The main objective of the scheme is to reduce the number of dropouts and to increase the number of enrollment in Government schools. This scheme is introduced by Government of India and State government with the sharing of 60:40 and the monitoring, supervising and execution of this scheme under Zilla Panchayat, Akshara dasoha section is headed by the EO (Educational Officer), We are serving food about 11500 children in and around 93 Government, Government aided schools and NCLP special schools in Nandhini Layout, Sondekoppa and Ullala clusters. We feel that it is a great challengeable job to us because every day cooking and supplying food for 10482 children is very tough task but to serve for the poor children's benefit we have taken this scheme mid day meal program and implementing this scheme. There are various statistics about out of school children nearly 5 lakh children are out of school and have entered to various sectors and establishments to work. But to bring back to school Government has introduced various schemes in order to enroll children to the schools. The Mid Day Meal program is playing a very great major role in increasing the number of enrollment and retention of school dropouts.

### **PRE PRIMARY EDUCATION PROGRAMME:**

IPDP has initiated Early Childhood Care and Education program for the children ranging from 3-6 years as Preprimary Education especially for the poor children in the slum areas. The main objective of the program is to prevent malnutrition and to improve the health condition. The program also aims to provide basic education for the poor children. IPDP marked its beginning for the Pre primary education program in Jaibhuvaneshwari Nagar in Nandini Layout. Around 847 children are totally enrolled in the crèche from the period 2004-2020. The children are then promoted to various other schools. Around 640 children are studying in Standard 1 to Standard 7 in Raghurama primary school, Highway public school, Bangalore central public school, Nandhini public school, Parikrma humanity foundation and other recognized schools in the nearby areas. IPDP has set its target to enroll the poor children in Pre Primary Education so that they are not deprived from their birth rights. We are running this program to help the working women and to educate the people in slums to send their children for formal education. It helps in eradicating malnutrition and it also creates a good awareness for education and health aspects. The health checkup camps are also initiated for providing effective medical treatment to the crèche center. Around 145 children are getting benefit under this program on an annual basis. This project is supported by MCKS food for the Hungry foundation Karnataka. We would also like to include that **Mr. Naresh who was studying in Creche is now Working as supervisor in Mandovi Motors Honda company we are glad that he was student of Creche and leading his successful life.**

#### **SKILL TAILORING PROGRAM:**

Integrated Project for Development of People (IPDP) is successfully executing skill development program since 2019 .We did a humble beginning and now collaborated with Weir Mineral Pvt Ltd; we are successfully running the skill development program. We are providing free training and placement to the underprivileged youths and women nearby Nandhini Layout. Interested and underprivileged youth with age 18-40are provided with free Tailoring training courses to help them find a good job and earn their Livings .We are soon in the process to tie with other big entities in order to take skill development initiatives to the next level.

IPDP has been running the Women empowerment program for SHG women since 2016 under this project we have formed and promoted more than 1100 SHG's (self-help groups) in various areas of Bangalore Urban District and Tiptur taluk Tumkur District. Presently we are working with 32 slum areas and 5 hoblis of Tiptur Taluk, for the SHG's is concern we are always guiding them to manage and maintain the groups in good condition without default. Our staffs provide them the proper trainings on Group concepts and Maintenance of their Groups. In case the Group requires exposures and inputs, we organize the exposure visits to SHG Sangha. Each Staff members have been assigned with the specific numbers of groups like minimum 60 to maximum 80 groups. The main role of the coordinators is to visit the groups frequently and attend the monthly meetings and help them for the groups, this year we have organized Women's rights workshop for SHG women's to know the women rights and in case if any assistance required the women we are providing services to the needy by connecting legal assistance from contacts. Supporting them for marking linkages and organized a International women's day celebration for the SHG women's and organized games for the women's in the program.

### **FEEDING PROGRAMS FOR SENIOR CITIZENS AT BANGALORE URBAN SLUMS:**

IPDP has initiated this program for senior citizens of Bangalore urban slums previously from BBMP support Akshaya Pathra Foundation was serving food to the senior citizens in BBMP limit Areas but in 2013 they stopped the program after that they were waiting this feeding program but from Government it was not restarted, our President Mr.S. Jayaraman had long term plan to serve the senior citizens by providing one meal to eradicate hunger of the old age people in the slums from IPDP we approached MCKS TRUST FUND about this feeding for poor Senior Citizens in the Urban slums and really there is a need for one time meal for the poor deserved old people and Identified the beneficiaries and submitted the proposal then this program was started and supporting this project and since last two years and they are supporting us to feed about 300 senior citizens at Jaibhuvaneshwari Nagar, Lakshmidewi Nagar Lakshmi Devi Nagara Colony and Sanjay Nagar slums in Laggere Areas in Bangalore Urban District.

IPDP started this feeding project in 2006 to provide one meal to the health checkup camp senior citizens at Place from Dr. Ramana Rao's free health checkup camp for the poor patients for the rural area senior citizens the patients leave their home by 6.00 am and they reach the village clinic by 8.00 am and return home by 10.30am, therefore we planned for this poor patients by giving them one meal will give more strength and energy to return home by hope I had something for my stomach and reach their home hence we approached MCKS TRUST FUND to support one meal for 600 patient's and now it is increased up to 1200 patients this free health checkup and treatments started in 1974 by Dr.Ramana Rao and till date he serving for poor last 42yearsat his free village clinic T.Begur,Nelamangala taluk, Bangalore Rural District. Free service with love and dedication we cannot believe that one person doing health checkup for 1200 person in 4 hours

### **TATA POWER SOLAR PROGRAM :-**

Integrated Project for Development of People has taken up the Safe drinking water project, a CSR initiative of TATA POWER SOLAR. Access to safe drinking water near TATA POWER SOLAR plant project sites around Pavagada/Ananthpur/Kadiri for strengthening the ability of Communities to Install & maintain sustainable and safe drinking water availability in 10 Villages of Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh gram Panchayat or Wards. This Project covers 7,000 to 10,000 beneficiaries and among them 60% are SC & ST beneficiaries and another 40% are of general category. The Focus is to provide safe drinking water to the villages in selected Areas to protect the People from fluorosis and other water related health issues.

Base line Survey for the Project: We have done the Base Line survey work in Pavagada, Ananthpura and Kadiri, in 14 villages and from them most deserving 10 villages were selected. There is real need as people are suffering from fluoride contamination and hardness in water. To protect the future generation from health related problems due to unsafe water, we have installed safe drinking water plants in 10 Villages with the support of TATA POWER SOLAR, as their CSR project.

The safe drinking water plants installed in 10 villages with the support of community intervention and we have formed water committees in all villages consisting of 4 members to look after and take care of RO plants in the villages they manage and guide the women and men who come for to fetch the water from RO plants using the smart cards if any technical problems in the plants immediately bring to the coordinators knowledge and problems will be resolved in time, to manage RO plants in Pavagada and Kadiri we have developed the coordination and supervision mechanism for the smooth operation of the system.

The RO plants which we installed in the villages are totally automated system with solar panels so that it works 24\*7 all 31 days in a month, the maintenance of the RO plants will be taken care by IPDP one year and after that it will be handed over to the community and at least 5 years minimum the RO plants should run by the community and IPDP will monitor and guide the community for the sustainability of the project.
