## SELF HELP GROUPS

IPDP has been running savings and credit program for the needy women in slums and other needy communities. Under this project we formed and promoted 1618 SHGs of about 21000 members in various areas of Bangalore Urban District, Chanpatna Ramnagar district Tiptur Taluk and Tumkur District. We are guiding SHGs to manage and maintain their activities properly without default. Our coordinators mainly play the role of facilitator between Self Help Group and ICICI BANK. We are recommending a minimum sum of Rs.1.5 lakh to maximum sum of Rs. 10 lakh per group from the ICICI Bank. This year we organized ICICI Bank loans amounting to more than Rs.13.5 crores for SHGs in current financial year.



## AKSHARA DASOHA ( MID DAY MEAL )

IPDP is successfully running Akshara Dasoha Mid-day Meal program for 92 schools that includes Government school & Government-aided schools in Nandini layout, Sondekoppa, Yelahanka, Rajanukunte, Devanahalli ,Ullal Upanagar, Hegganahalli, Laggere & Vidhyaranyapura clusters in Bangalore North, Urban District. The main objective of this scheme is to reduce the number of dropouts and to increase the enrollment in Government schools. This scheme is introduced by the Government of India and the Government of Karnataka with the sharing of 60:40. The monitoring, supervising and execution of this scheme is under Zilla Panchayat. Akshara Dasoha section is headed by the EO (Educational Officer). Through mid-day meal Scheme about 11833 children are getting benefited every day.





## ASHAKIRANA RESIDENTIAL HOSTEL

While working with slum community. We found that there is a need of residential shelter for children in crisis in slum community. IPDP initially started its Ashakirana Residential Shelter at Jaibhuvaneshwari nagar. Now we are running our residential hostel at our office premises with Good infrastructure facilities. In the year 2006 especially for the poor children with the support of Sarva Shikshana Abhiyana (SSA) Government of India. We accommodate 50 children from different age group to continue their formal education by providing shelter, food and cloths, the main aim of the program is to mainstream the school dropout children to formal school. All our hostel Children are enrolled in Veena High School from 2nd Standard to 10<sup>th</sup> Standard to continue their studies. This Program is supported by MCKS Trust Fund and Weir Minerals India Pvt Ltd.



## FEEDING PROGRAM FOR HEALTH CAMP

Dr. Ramana Rao's renowned free village clinic at T. Begur in Nelamangala taluk (Bangalore Rural District) is offering free medical services for poor rural citizens since 1974 and is conducting free checkup camps. Where about 700 to 1000 patients are treated in village clinic. We were supported by MCKS TRUST FUND, to cook and supply food for about 700 to 1000 health camp patients every Sunday. The patients come from local areas upto 25 to 35 km distance to get free medical support and treatment from this health camp .

## FEEDING PROGRAM OF SENIOR CITIZEN – A MID DAY MEAL

While working with the slum community we were approached by group of elderly people for one time meal on daily basis, as their family member goes to work early in the morning were they don't get food in the afternoon. We took the request seriously and came up with a plan of providing lunch meal to elderly people every day. We got the support from MCKS TRUST FUND to provide meal every day to elderly people. We are running this program successfully since 2015. Under this program 300 elderly people are getting benefited every day in Kaveri Nagar, Lakshmi Devi Nagar Colony and Sanjay Gandhi Nagar slums in the Laggere area in Bangalore Urban District.



## FEEDING PROGRAM OF PRE PRIMARY EDUCATION – A MID DAY MEAL

IPDP has initiated Early Childhood care and education program for children ranging from 3-6 years by providing pre-primary education especially for poor children in slum areas. The main objective of the program is to prevent malnutrition and to improve the health condition of the children. The program also aims to provide basic education for the poor children. We started creche program at Jaibhuvaneshwari nagar and successfully promoted 857 children to formal school from 2004-2022.





## SKILL TRAINING PROGRAM – HEALTH CARE , BFSI & TIPTUR SOFT SKILLS

IPDP executed Skill Training Program successfully in the year 2014, where we provide free training and job placement for underprivileged youth. Who are aged between 18-28 year. We Train them with banking and financial service insurance, Health care basics computer, spoken English, personality development, retail management and career counseling. This program is supported by Smile Foundation in 2 centers in Shrike, and online digital center in Bangalore district and 1 skill training center in Tiptur supported by MCKS Food For The Hungry Foundation Karnataka. So far we have trained 2588 youth and done job placement for 1941 youth in different profession based on their ability and interest. Job placement for the youth project is supported by Rotary Bangalore down town charitable trust.



## HCLF LIVELIHOOD PROGRAM

- To alleviate poverty, create employment and income generating opportunity through Micro enterprises and livelihood development.
- To develop capacity and skills of the target groups on micro enterprises. Development/management as well as Self Help Groups management.
- To upgrade vocational skills of the target people on livestock rearing, tailoring and allied activities.
- To provide initial capital fund for undertaking income generation activities and inculcating self-confidence on running of small business management profitably.



## SKILL TRAINING PROGRAM – TAILORING CENTER

Integrated Project for Development of People (IPDP) is successfully executing skill development program since 2019 .We did a humble beginning and now collaborated with Weir Mineral Pvt Ltd. The underprivileged youths and women age between 18-40 nearby Adakamarana halli. Where we are providing free tailoring training to help them to find a good job to earn their Livings. We are in the process to tie up with other big entities in order to take tailoring program initiatives to the next level.



## TARGET CORPORATION FINANCIAL LITERACY & LEGAL WORKSHOP PROGRAM FOR SHG WOMENS

IPDP has been running the Women Empowerment program for SHG women since 2016 under this project we have formed and promoted more than 1300 SHG's (self-help groups) in various areas of Bangalore Urban District, Channapatna and Tiptur taluk Tumkur District for the SHG's is concern we are always guiding them to manage and maintain the groups in good condition without default. Our staffs provide them the proper training on Group concepts and Maintenance of their Groups. In case the Group requires exposures and inputs, we organize the exposure visits to SHG Sangha. Each Staff members have been assigned with the specific numbers of groups like minimum 60 to maximum 80 groups. Along with this we also provide them various awareness program such as legal awareness program and health awareness program and we all so provide them counseling for their domestic issues .
